Absorb the remaining liquid and any small spills with clay granules, sand, or other absorbent materi and sweep into a waste container. Minimise run-off into drains or waterways.							
Fire	Vapours may	Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Vapours may be toxic. Self-contained breathing apparatus required; chemical suit recommended. Addition of water may cause excessive foaming. Do not allow contaminated run-off to enter drains or waterways.
