**STORAGE:** Store locked up. Store in original container, tightly closed and in a dry, cool area away from foodstuffs. Store in accordance with NZS 8409 Management of Agrichemicals.  
**DISPOSAL:** Avoid contamination of any water supply with product or empty container. Triple rinse empty container placing rinse water in the spray tank. If recycling, discard cap and deliver clean container to an Agrecovery depot or crush and bury in an approved landfill. Dispose of product only by using according to this label, or at an approved landfill or disposal facility.  
**SPILLAGE:** Wear appropriate protective clothing. Exclude all bystanders from the vicinity of the spill and prevent material from entering waterways. AREA OF USE	RATE	DIRECTIONS
<b>GLASSHOUSES</b>	100 - 200 ml/10 litres of water	Spray to run off and leave for 24 hours. For big problem areas: wash 24 hours after first spray and reapply. Repeat where necessary.
<b>PATIO AREAS, PATHS &amp; DRIVEWAYS: concrete, asphalt, &amp; cobblestones</b>	200 ml/10 litres of water	For heavy infestation clean off after 48 hours and reapply. Repeat if necessary.
<b>POTTED ORNAMENTALS</b>	100 - 150 ml/10 litres of water	Spray media/soil in pot, ensuring good coverage of liverwort and moss. Where spray contacts foliage, irrigate within 30 minutes of application to wash spray from foliage.
<b>SANITISER</b>	75 ml/10 litres of water	Use as a wash or spray as required.
<b>SHADE CLOTH, WINDBREAK, SYNTHETIC TURF, WEEDMAT</b>	150 ml/10 litres of water	Spray on area to be treated.
<b>TURF: fine turf &amp; cotula</b>	250 - 500 ml/10 litres of water or 2 - 5 litres/100 litres/1000m <sup>2</sup>	Ensure the area to be treated is thoroughly wet first. Use higher rate where severe moss infestations are present. Best results will be achieved under warm active growth conditions.
<b>Vegetable &amp; fruit boxes. Patio containers, earthenware &amp; ornaments</b>	100 ml/10 litres of water	Remove excess dirt and dip in a solution for 30 minutes, remove and allow to dry.

**MIXING:** Yield will foam on application and agitation. When mixing add Yield after filling the spray tank with the appropriate amount of water.

**METHOD OF APPLICATION:** Apply ensuring the treated area is thoroughly wet. CAUTION: Do not apply to soft seedlings or lower order plants such as ferns. Drought stressed plants may also be adversely affected. When applying to growing plants test a small sample to ensure that treatment will not be harmful. The foliage of some plants may be damaged if contacted with the spray.
