Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Can I spray around the plants in my garden?

A. TAG G2 is not suited for home garden use as damage to desirable plants is likely.

Q. Can I spray under my shelterbelt?

A. TAG G2 can be safely used as a ground treatment under well-established shelter species at a rate up to 10/litres/Ha.

Q. I have just sprayed my lawn with TAG G2 by mistake, what can I do now?

A. Cut and store the entire turf layer including main root mass to 2cm depth. Re-sow lawn after testing a small area for grass survival for at least three weeks following emergence. Otherwise wait until it dies off and sow a new lawn after waiting six to nine months depending on rate applied. Again test a small area for grass emergence and survival.

Q. How long will the tank load of TAG G2 I've just mixed up last before spraying?

A. If it is kept agitated or re-dispersed it will last up to three days.

Q. Can I spray beside a waterway with TAG G2?

A. Beside a waterway is OK so long as the slope of the terrain prevents leaching into it.

Q. What weeds won't TAG G2 kill?

A. Large woody perennial weeds such as gorse will re-grow. Large tufted perennial grasses such as cocksfoot may re-grow.

Q. Can I mix TAG G2 with other products?

A. Yes.

Q. I've just sprayed my drive with TAG G2, should I keep my dog/cat inside?

A. As a cautious practice do not have pets present during spraying. Contact once spray has dried is safe to all animals.

Q. How long will TAG G2 last?

A. Length of weed control depends on the rate applied, soil type, rainfall and the type of weeds likely to germinate. In general 10L/Ha will provide 2 to 3 months control but this can be longer in light soils under low rainfall. 20L/Ha can give up to 12 months of control before significant weed escapes are seen. Application timing can improve results as summer applications tend to last for a shorter period. It is important to monitor effects on your property and modify rates and application frequency to suit. Sometimes an alternative knockdown herbicide will be required between applications particularly in the summer.

Q. Can I use it in my stock races?

A. TAG G2 is particularly useful in stock races and access roads. As a cautionary practice it is advisable to spray weeds at least 7 days before stock have access.

Q. Is it safe around trees?

A. Most established trees will not be affected by TAG G2 but some young and/or shallow rooted shrubs (e.g. azaleas) and trees can be killed with high rates applied over the root zone.

Q. Will TAG G2 work on dusty or dirty weeds?

A. Weed material should be free of dust and dirt so before spraying wait for rainfall or significant new growth before spraying.
